IMPORTANT POLICIES

- Faculty reserve the right to drop students who do not attend the first class session.
- Students are not permitted to attend classes in which they are not officially enrolled; auditing is not permitted.

PLEASE NOTE: if the class you wish to take is full, an interested student has the option to go to the first class and ask the instructor for permission to add the class. If the instructor approves, the instructor will provide an Add Permit Code (APC) and the individual will be added to the roster.

FEES

Emeritus Institute courses are tuition free, non-credit classes. As noted in this schedule, classes on the Saddleback College campus require a \$17 health-fee payment. Some courses require a material fee. All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Payment may be made by credit card when registering online, or by check or money order when registering in-person; no cash is accepted. Payments must be received within five business days to avoid enrollment cancellation.

NOTE: Summer classes held at the Saddleback College campus require students to purchase a \$25 student parking permit, online, through MySite.

REFUND DEADLINE – Classes must be dropped by May 31, 2019 to receive a refund.

LAGUNA WOODS VILLAGE PARKING PASSES

STUDENT PARKING FEE

Laguna Woods Village (LWV) requires non-resident students who drive a vehicle into the community to pay a Student Parking Pass Fee, which is \$15 per vehicle for the spring semester. Payment may be made by check or cash.

Laguna Woods Village does not refund parking pass purchases.

Only one parking pass per vehicle needs to be presented when students are carpooling.

Students walking in will need to arrange for GATE CLEARANCE with an Emeritus staff member.

PAYMENT / PICK-UP

Student Parking Passes will be available for payment and pick-up at the Laguna Woods Village Community Center, as scheduled above. **Passes will not be mailed.**

Students registering after the above dates must have a Saddleback College Emeritus Institute Parking Pass Application completed by a Saddleback College staff member before purchasing a parking pass. This form is available by calling either Emeritus Institute Office.

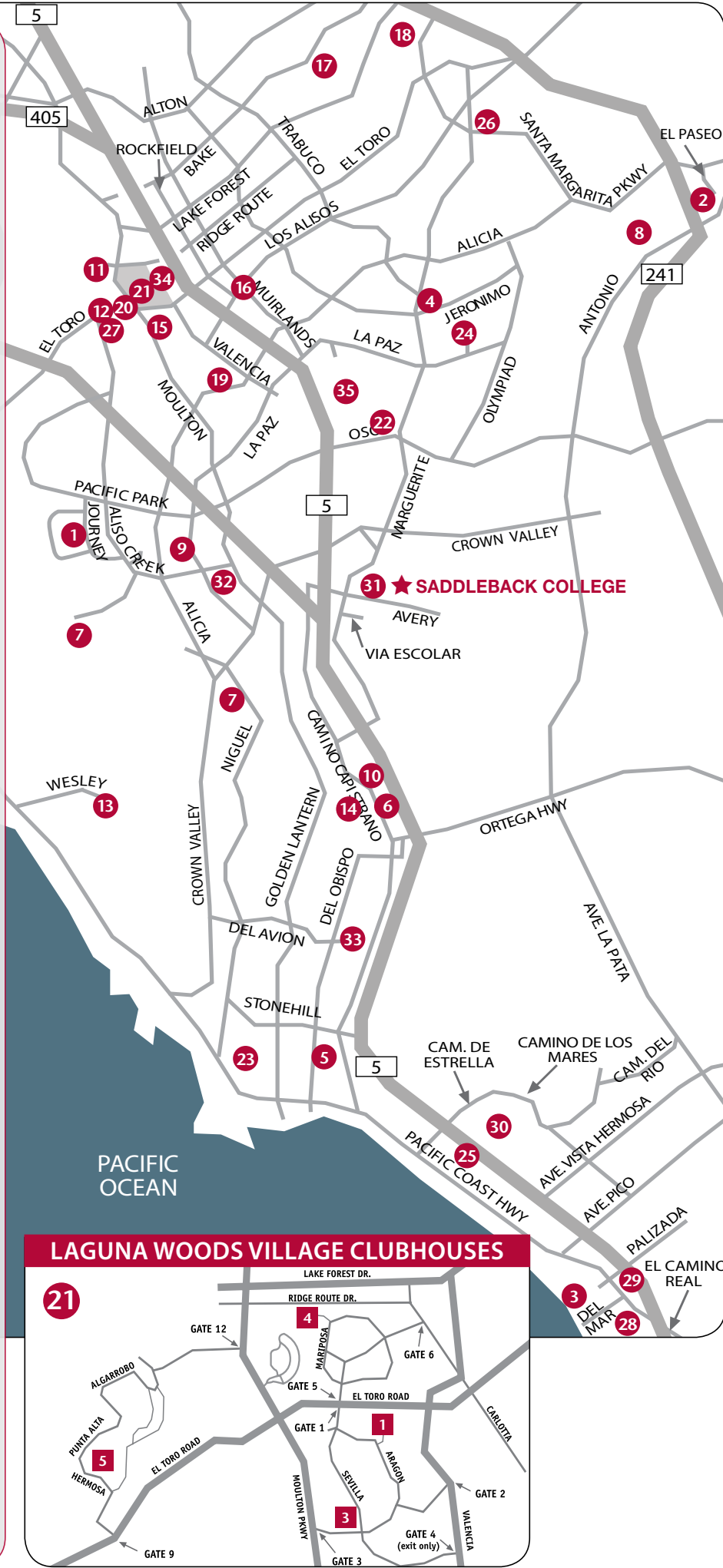

WHAT IS A CLASS SCHEDULE "TIME CONFLICT"?



- Students cannot enroll in any class that conflicts in time with another class they are already enrolled in.
- Students may enroll in as many classes as they like each semester, but there can be no day/time overlap between any classes.
- When a time conflict occurs, the student must decide if they want to keep the class they are already enrolled or drop the class they're enrolled in and enroll in the previously conflicting class.
- A class can be dropped online via MySite on the Saddleback College website (www.saddleback.edu). If the student doesn't have a computer, they may complete a Drop Card at one of the Emeritus Offices.
- When late-adding a class after the semester begins, be sure to review your course schedule closely to make sure there are no time conflicts between classes.

HOW TO LATE-ADD AN EMERITUS CLASS

- 1) Go to the class when it meets to ask the instructor if you can be added.
If the class meets in Laguna Woods Village, and you're a non-resident, call the Emeritus Office so we can arrange for one-time gate clearance at least 24 hours in advance. (949-582-4835)
 - If you are a New Student or a Returning Student (who has missed a spring or fall semester) bring a fully-completed Emeritus Application* with you.
 - If the class has a material fee (see course description in class schedule), bring a check or a money order. (Cash and credit cards cannot be accepted.)
- 2) If the instructor can add you, complete the APC add slip the instructor gives you by PRINTING your name at the bottom and your student ID number (if you're current or returning).
- 3) The completed APC (and application, if applicable) need to be handed back to the instructor to submit for you (with your Materials Fee check, if applicable).
 - If the class has a materials fee, your check (made to Saddleback College) needs to be attached to the APC, as well. Write your Student ID number on the check, if you have one.
- 4) The instructor will submit your paperwork to the Admissions Office, who will process it so you'll be officially enrolled in the class.

HOW TO PURCHASE A LAGUNA WOODS VILLAGE PARKING PASS

- Students who are enrolled in a class that meets in Laguna Woods Village and are not residents are required to purchase a LWV semester parking pass in order to enter the community and park their car.
- Laguna Woods charges \$30 for a Fall and Spring Semester Parking Pass, and \$15 for Summer Session Parking Pass
- If you PRE-REGISTER for a LWV class before the semester begins:
 - Your name will be submitted to Laguna Woods Village. Check the Emeritus Institute Class Schedule for the days, times and location that you can purchase your pass from Laguna Woods Village.
- If you LATE-ADD A LWV class after the semester begins:
 - Tell your instructor that you'll be purchasing a LWV Parking Pass so your APC add slip gets submitted to the Admissions Office quickly.
 - After your class enrollment shows in our system, an Emeritus Staff Member can email a form to Laguna Woods Village enabling you to go to the LWV Community Center* to purchase a Parking Pass.
 - If your class meets at LWV Clubhouse 4, you can speak with the Emeritus Staff Member at the Clubhouse 4 Emeritus Office regarding a Parking Pass.
- If you need temporary gate clearance anytime through this process, please contact an Emeritus Staff Member at least 24 hours in advance for assistance.
- If you will NOT be parking a car during the semester, and instead will be walking in, or using a taxi/Lyft/Uber, please contact an Emeritus Staff Member for further information.
